'Tamar Tootle' Day

A family fun cycle/walk
round Upper Tamar lake

with quiz questions

There is a café and picnic benches, plus the
new play area beside the café is open.

The 'Tamar Tootle' is an easy-standard wide grit cyclepath, that undulates through magnificent lakeside scenery. It is 5km long and suitable for beginner-level cyclists. However, the surface is a bit rough for small-wheel scooters on much of the route. A shorter 1km route with a quiz is available; this may be better for scooters.

There is no event entry fee; just collect your quiz sheet from the start desk (beside the car park*) any time between 11am and 3pm and set off on your chosen route. Children should be accompanied by responsible adults.
